because our arguments must be sound and not based on self-serving ideologies or agendas.




Our Platform

Fiscal Responsibility

Academic Excellence

Helping students develop and achieve academically to prepare for life and work is a fundamental priority of public education.

A VIVA Victoria-led School District 61 will:

- Support measures that enable students to successfully demonstrate their ability to perform, achieve and excel in their scholastic endeavours.
- Advance initiatives that build student resilience and encourage their mental, physical and emotional wellbeing to prepare them for challenging life experiences.
- Prioritize high-quality instruction and participation in music, art, science, math and English, including exposure to great classic literature.

Transparency and Parental Involvement

We believe parents are the primary stakeholders in their children's education.

A VIVA Victoria-led School District 61 will:

- Ensure parents are free to express concerns and advocate for their children, knowing they will always be heard.
- Guarantee parents of all ethnic, religious and cultural backgrounds and orientations that they will be treated equally and respected and their voices will be represented.

- Ensure the School Board always acts with integrity and transparency, represents parents and supports teachers, and does not act in the pursuit of personal or political agendas.
- Hold all relevant School Board discussions in the open for public scrutiny and not behind closed doors or off the record. The public has a right to know.

Fiscal Responsibility

School Trustees have a responsibility to act wisely and prudently with public education funding.

A VIVA Victoria-led School District 61 will:

- Establish robust budget review and accountability procedures to ensure all financial accounting is transparent and the public is adequately informed about revenues and expenditures.
- Not spend scarce and valuable education resources on destructive lawsuits that do not improve the quality of education students receive.
- Act always in the best interests of students and families and direct funds to learning priorities, not pet projects that do not align with fundamental educational objectives.
